Social Studies

We have just finished up our geography unit. Students took a test on the continents, oceans, hemispheres, and compass rose yesterday. You will find them corrected in folders next week.

Science

Coming up next we will be studying a unit about states of matter and weather. This will include learning about solids, liquids, gases and how temperature causes changes of state. They will study about evaporation, condensation, types of clouds, water cycle, and climate/precipitation in Oregon.

MATH

Over the course of the first few weeks of school we have been working on graphing (bar graphs primarily), re-

viewing basic addition and subtraction facts, and building strategies for double-digit addition. If you are having your child use IXL at home for extra practice, those areas would be good for kids to focus on at this time of the year. Our next unit will start taking a look at multiplication and division. I am sending home a unit overview sheet for parents today in Friday Folders.
